Change of Circumstances for all benefits.

If you have any changes in your circumstances it is essential you notify the Department for Work and Pensions immediately.

Claiming what you're not entitled to could lead to a serious fine, loss of benefits, a criminal record or even a prison sentence.

Examples of changes include living with a partner, securing work and a change in caring responsibilities.

National living wage Changes

From April 2016, the national living wage will be **£7.20** an hour for workers aged **25 and older**.

The minimum wage will still apply for workers aged 24 and under.

National Minimum Wage rates

Year 21 and over: £6.70

18 to 20 : £5.30

Under 18: £3.87

Apprentice: £3.30

**This rate is for apprentices aged 16 to 18 and those aged 19 or over who are in their first year. All other apprentices are entitled to the National Minimum Wage for their age.

The rates are usually updated every October - the current rates apply from October 2015.*

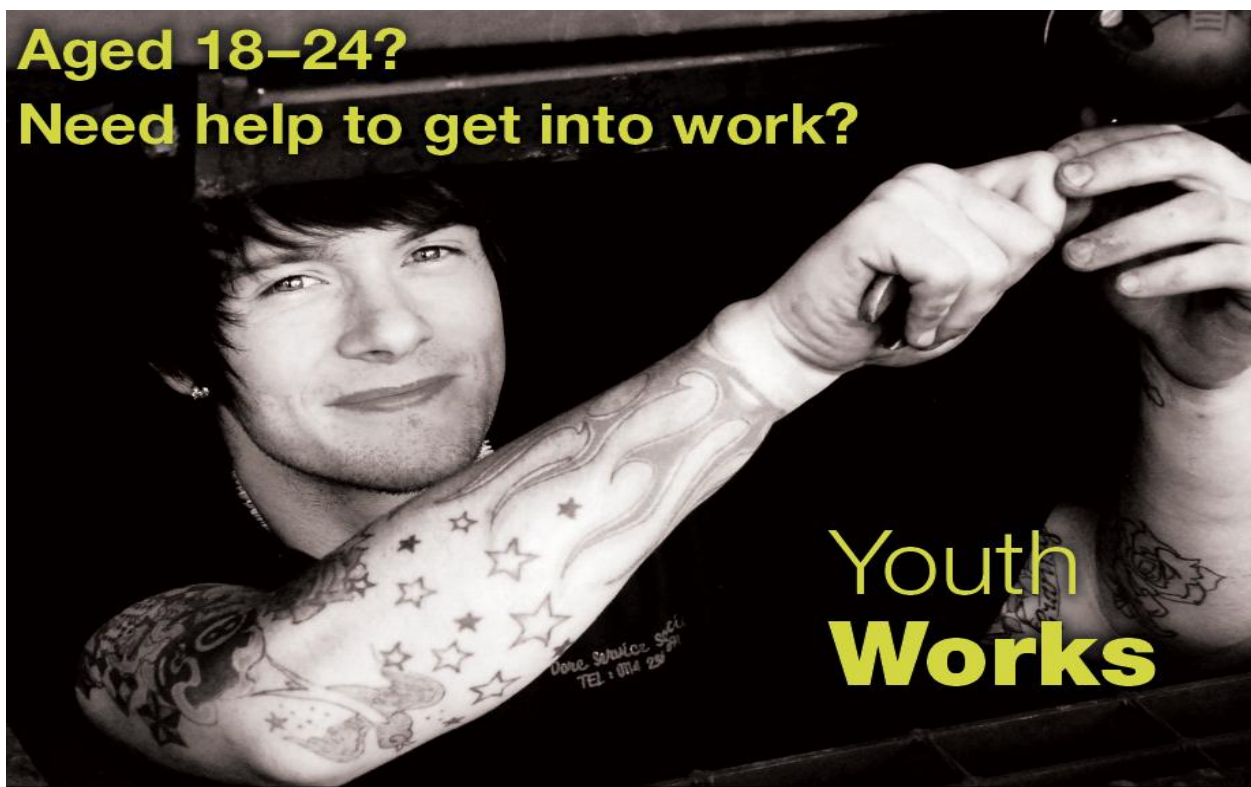

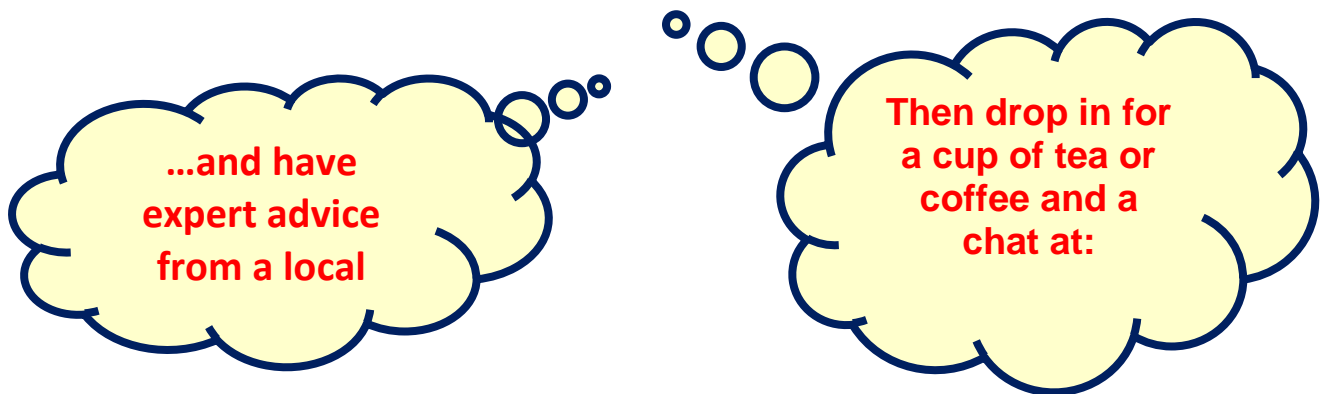

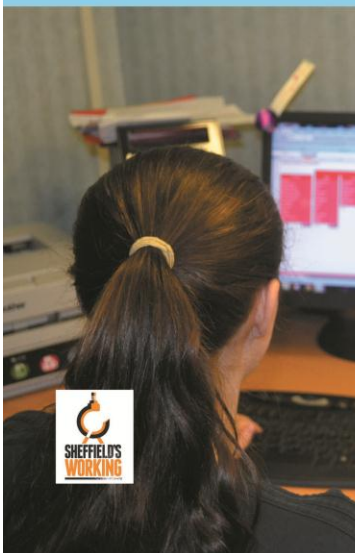
